Ivy Lane & Rosemount Court, West End – proposed ‘No Waiting at Any Time’ restrictions

STATEMENT OF REASONS

Ivy Lane

The junction of Ivy Lane and the A27 regularly has parking at the junction bell mouth and across the pedestrian crossing point. This inappropriate parking results in a higher risk to drivers and pedestrians using this junction.

To address these problems it is proposed to prevent on street parking within the junction bell mouth in accordance with the good parking practice mentioned in the Highway Code section 243. By this method it can be ensured that drivers are visible to each other thus reducing the likelihood of a collision.

Rosemount Court

The junction of Rosemount Court and the A27 regularly has parking at the junction bell mouth and either side of the Rosemount Court access. This inappropriate parking results in a higher risk to drivers using this junction.

To address these problems it is proposed to amend the existing ‘No Waiting at Any Time’ restriction and indicate where drivers may park with the use of marked parking bays. It is proposed to prevent parking within the junction bell mouth in accordance with the good parking practice mentioned in the Highway Code section 243, as well as across the access and opposite the access to Rosemount Court. By this method it can be ensured that drivers do not obstruct junction access. With parking being at a premium in this area the total number of spaces will be maintained but clearly marked to ensure parked vehicles do not cause obstruction.
