Aim of the project

To provide support to help you improve, adapt and maintain your house to keep it safe, warm and secure.

Who can apply?

Any person over 70 years of age and who is a home owner.

Where is it available?

In Eastleigh, New Forest and Test Valley Borough/District council boundaries.

How long is it available?

It is initially available from October 2010 - March 2011.



How can Safe, Warm and Secure help me?

There are Safe, Warm and Secure advisors whose role is to provide you with free guidance and support when you have decided to improve the safety, warmth and security of your home. It is often daunting to have to make all the arrangements on your own. The Safe, Warm and Secure advisor will be there to help you until completion of the work.

The project is not able to provide funding for any of these improvements.

The work can include:-

- Identifying available grants and benefits
- Home repairs - e.g. paving stones replaced, windows and doors mended
- Loft and cavity wall insulation incl. loft clearance
- Home security - e.g. locks, door chains fitted
- Adaptations - e.g. rails, stairlifts, ramps
- Community alarms and Telecare
- Arranging free home safety visits.
