

THE BOROUGH OF EASTLEIGH (CHANDLERS FORD AND HILTINGBURY) (AMENDMENT NO 8) ORDER 2021

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Eastleigh Borough Council pursuant to arrangements with Hampshire County Council has made the above mentioned Traffic Regulation Order in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 1, 2, 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The effect of the Order will be to:

1. Remove "No waiting at any time" restrictions in the following roads: **Reliant Close north-east side** from 12 metres north-west of its junction with School Lane north-westwards for 15 metres; **Trafalgar Close north-east side** from 10 metres north-west of its junction with School Lane north-westwards for 15 metres;
2. Introduce "No waiting at any time" restrictions in the following roads: **Reliant Close south-west side** from 35 metres north west of its junction with School Lane north-westwards for 24 metres; **Trafalgar Close north-east side** from 82 metres north-west of its junction with School Lane north-westwards to its north-western closed end, **south-west side** from 74 metres north-west of its junction with School Lane north-westwards to its **north-western closed end**, north-western closed end for its entire length;
3. Introduce "No waiting at any time on footway or verge" restrictions in the following roads: **Heathfield Close all sides** for their entire lengths, **Heathfield Road both sides** for their entire lengths, **Walnut Close all sides** for their entire lengths;
4. Introduce a maximum of six Disabled Persons Parking Places in the following roads: **Ashdown Road, Avon Green, Chalvington Road, Charnwood Close, Cumberland Avenue, Hillcrest Avenue, Hiltingbury Road, Kerry Close, Kingsway, Merrieleas Drive, Milford Gardens, Pantheon Road, Porteous Crescent, Purkess Close, Ribble Close, Saxon Walk, Shaftesbury Avenue, Steele Close, Tadburn Close, Warren Avenue**

The Order will come into operation on 6 September 2021 . A copy of the Order may be inspected at my office at the Eastleigh House, Upper Market Street, Eastleigh during normal office hours or on the Council's website: www.eastleigh.gov.uk/TRO

Any persons wishing to question the validity of this Order or any provisions contained in it on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, or any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within six weeks from 1 September 2021 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
