

**THE BOROUGH OF EASTLEIGH
(BURSLEDON, HAMBLE-LE-RICE AND HOUND)
(AMENDMENT NO 14) ORDER 2022**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that The Council of the Borough of Eastleigh (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”) pursuant to arrangements made with the Hampshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby has made the above Order.

The effect of which would be to:

1. Introduce ‘Areas on the Highway designated Heavy Goods Vehicle Loading Bays’ in the following road: **Station Road** *south-east side* from a point 21.5 metres north-east of its junction with New Road in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 13 metres.

The Order will come into operation on 30 January 2023. A copy of the Order may be inspected at Eastleigh House, Upper Market Street, Eastleigh during normal office hours or on the Council’s website: www.eastleigh.gov.uk/TRO.

Any persons wishing to question the validity of this Order or any provisions contained in it on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, or any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within six weeks from **25 January 2023** apply to the High Court for this purpose.
