THE BOROUGH OF EASTLEIGH (EASTLEIGH TOWN CENTRE) (AMENDMENT NO 1) ORDER 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Eastleigh Borough Council pursuant to arrangements with Hampshire County Council has made the above mentioned Traffic Regulation Order in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 1, 2, 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The effect of the Order will be to:

1) Introduce 'No waiting at any time' restrictions in the following roads: Belmont Road north-west side from a point 10 metres south-west of its junction with Sussex Road north-eastwards to a point 10 metres north-east of that same junction; Derby Road north-east side from a point 5 metres east of the rear boundary of No.249a Market Street south-eastwards for 5 metres; Falcon Square (North-west corner) north, west and south-east sides from a point adjacent to the common boundary of Nos 87 & 89 Falcon Square westwards and then southwards to a point adjacent to the common boundary of Nos 79 & 81 Falcon Square; Falcon Square (Both rear Service Roads running north/south to the rear of Nos 26 to 32 & Nos 10 to 16 Falcon Square) both sides of both service roads for their entire lengths: Falcon Square (northernmost section running East/West) south side from a point 10 metres west of the junction with the westernmost service road to a point 10 metres east of that junction, and from a point 10 metres west of the junction with the easternmost service road to a point 10 metres east of that junction; Falcon Square (southernmost section running East/West) north side from a point 10 metres west of the junction with the westernmost service road to a point 10 metres east of that junction, and from a point 10 metres west of the junction with the easternmost service road to a point 10 metres east of that junction; Surrey Road both sides from the junction with Sussex Road westwards for a distance of 15 metres: Sussex Road west side from a point 15 metres south of the junction with Surrey Road northwards to a point 15 metres north of the same junction.

2) Amend 'Areas on the Highway Designated as Parking Places with Permits' restrictions in the following road: York Road southwest side from a point 10 metres south-east of the junction with Arnold Road south-eastwards to a point 15 metres north-west of the junction with Doncaster Road.

3) Amend 'No waiting at any time' restrictions in the following road: **York Road** both sides from the junction of Arnold Road south-eastwards for a distance of 10 metres.

4) Amend 'Waiting Limited to Four Hours Maximum Stay (Return Prohibited Within Two Hours) 8:00am-8:00pm Monday to Saturday. Exemption for Permit Holders – Carers Permit Three Hours' restrictions in the following road: **York Road** north-east side from a point 10 metres from the junction with Arnold Road south-eastwards to a point 15 metres north-west of the junction of Doncaster Road.

The proposals to introduce 'No waiting at any time' restrictions in Crestwood View have been abandoned.

Any persons wishing to question the validity of this Order or any provisions contained in it on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, or any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within six weeks from **22 March 2023** apply to the High Court for this purpose.
