The Statement of Community Involvement was adopted by Eastleigh Borough Council on 7 December 2023. The document sets out how Eastleigh Borough Council intends to involve the community, businesses, organisations and statutory agencies in decision on planning matters including the Local Plan and planning applications. It replaces the Statement of Community Involvement (2015) and Addendum SCI (2020).
