



Registration Service for Births, Deaths and Marriages

When a death occurs it must be registered within five days, by the Registrar of Births and Deaths for the area in which it occurred.

We have listed below the names, addresses and contact numbers of registration offices for your assistance.

The registration service operates an appointment system; please telephone the appropriate office to book an appointment. You also need to check whether only you need to go along. It may be that someone other than you will need to give information for the death to be registered. If the death has been referred to the coroner, it cannot be registered until the registrar has received authority from the coroner to do so.

Memorials

The purchase of the Exclusive Right of burial to a grave space includes the right to erect a memorial at the head of the grave. Please note this is subject to the authority's memorial regulations included in the policy for erection of Memorials and Memorial Safety.

Memorials remain the responsibility of the grave owners. If we notice an unsafe memorial, we will endeavor to contact the grave owner to arrange repair. Should any visitors notice

an unsafe memorial, please advise a member of staff or ring the office contact numbers as soon as possible.

All headstones/inscriptions are to be carried out by an Approved Monumental Mason.

Approved Monumental Masons

The following is a list of Approved Monumental Masons who have agreed to register with Eastleigh Borough Council and have agreed to work in accordance with our code of working practice. This is based on recommendations set out by the National Association of Memorial Masons to ensure safe fixing methods are used.

This list is for your guidance only. You are advised to make your own enquiries before deciding as to which company undertakes the work.

Rights and Options

The main requirements in England and Wales are that the death is certified by a doctor or coroner, registered with a Registrar of Births, Deaths & Marriages, and the body either buried or cremated.

- You do not have to have a funeral ceremony
- You do not have to use a religious minister
- You do not have to use a funeral director
- A ceremony does not have to take place in a crematorium or place of worship

There are more options concerning the content of a funeral ceremony and its duration than many people realise.

Many people choose to make their arrangements through a funeral director. However, some people see 'do-it-yourself' funerals as more personal and less expensive

You can obtain information from the Natural Death Centre. Some funeral directors are willing to help with such funerals.

A Simple Funeral

Most people would require the funeral director to provide the following services as a minimum:

- Make all necessary arrangements
- Provide appropriate staff
- Provide a suitable coffin
- Transfer the deceased from the place of death to the funeral director's premises
- Care for the deceased prior to the funeral
- Provide a hearse to the nearest cemetery or crematorium
- Arrange for burial or cremation as appropriate

Embalming, viewing of the deceased, or providing a limousine for mourners are optional extras.

Choosing a Funeral Director

Funeral directors will manage funeral arrangements and give advice and support. Check if the funeral director you choose belongs to a trade association. This requires them to provide full information about their services and prices.

These factors may influence your choice:

- Location of the firm's premises
- Range of services provided
- The way you are treated by the staff
- Cost
- Recommendation of those who have used the service
- Ownership (small family business or large firm)

a) About the Service Provided by Eastleigh Borough Council

b) About the Service Provided by a Funeral Director

Most funerals are conducted well, but if you have a justified complaint, you should contact your funeral director. If you are not satisfied with the response, you can complain to whichever of the three trade associations listed below your funeral director belongs to:

- The National Association of Funeral Directors (NAFD)
- The National Society of Allied and Independent Funeral Directors (SAIF)
