Key Projects & Priorities

- Conduct a review of youth provision across HEWEB and support Botley Parish Council in the implementation of a youth programme at Boorley Park
- ► Implement eight street planters on the three high streets in HEWEB
- ▶ Deliver on the Public art Vision for HFWFB
- Support the public art project on Hatch Farm
- Work in Partnership with key agencies such as the police, public health and the Utilita Bowl
- ► Look at the possible expansion of Hedge End Unwrapped
- ► Itchen Valley Country Park complete delivery of Masterplan project by June 2024
- Review the feasibility of enhancing leisure provision at Wildern school

- Conduct a feasibility study for Telegraph Woods to enhance the bio-diversity, improve path and waterways and explore the possibility of a dedicated cycle area
- Establish a long term plan for the site, 'New Place' to benefit the community
- Collaborate with key partners to reduce speeding along local roads
- ► Ensure available developer contributions are allocated in 2024/25
- ➤ To support future housing projects and engage with local communities to maximise community benefit
- Ensure the asset transfer of Boorley Park allotments, the sport pitches and the pavilion to Botley Parish Council is completed
