TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Places will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. There is a maximum number of swimmers at one time. Please ensure your child is accompanied until their entry is confirmed.

Any child under the age of eight years-old will need to be accompanied by a full paying adult (aged 16+). A maximum of two children are permitted per adult.
Over 8s unaccompanied must be able to swim 25m unaided.

Any misbehaviour will not be tolerated. Wildern Leisure Centre have the right to ask participants to leave the premises and participants will lose their right to return to any future Free Swimming sessions.
