Notes and conditions on applications for advisory access markings

1. This road marking's purpose is to indicate:
Part of the carriageway outside an entrance to off-street premises or a private drive, or where the kerb is dropped to provide a convenient crossing place for pedestrians, which should be kept clear of waiting vehicles.
2. Each submission will be investigated and the applicant advised of the outcome of their request.
3. Eastleigh Borough Council reserves the right **not to approve** certain applications for this advisory restriction. Examples include wide dropped kerbs spanning several properties, and locations where parking restrictions such as yellow lines already exist.
4. If the application is not approved, this decision is final and cannot be appealed.
5. If approval is granted then the marking will be introduced in accordance with the current regulations and subject to the timescales in 9 and 10 below.
6. It must be accepted that these markings are purely advisory and will not be patrolled in the same manner as on street parking restrictions.
7. Payment must be made before the marking is implemented, in the form of a Cheque or Postal Order, payable to Eastleigh Borough Council and crossed a/c payee.
8. Payment must be attached to the application form, and will be processed only if the request is approved.
9. If the marking is not approved the cheque/postal order will be returned to you.
10. The cost of this marking is £90. Blue Badge holders are exempt from payment (photocopy of Blue Badge must accompany application form). It will be programmed in alongside other normal works, which normally takes approximately eight to twelve weeks.
11. Completion of lining works is subject to staff and contractors' availability and workload, and factors beyond the control of Eastleigh Borough Council such as weather conditions. The council shall not be held liable for delays arising from these or similar factors.
12. Please note that the payment for these works relates solely to the first marking implemented. Should the marking need refreshing in future then a further payment of £90 will be necessary. This however does not apply if the carriageway has been resurfaced or works undertaken on the highway making relining necessary; in these circumstances the contractor carrying out the works will meet the cost of the lining.
