

Car Boot sale sellers rules 2018

1. You shall **INDEMNIFY** the Council against all claims, actions, injuries, losses, demands or expenses (whether direct or indirect) which may arise out of or in consequence of Your act or omission in connection with the use and occupation of the Council's land for the said car boot sale.
2. The Council **WILL NOT** be liable to any loss, theft, or damage caused to You except to any liability for death or personal injury caused by the Council's negligence.
3. You enter the site at your own risk.
4. Eastleigh Car Boot Sale is to be held on the Leigh Road Market Place and Car Park on Saturdays from 9am to 2pm.
5. The Car Boot Sale will not run when there is another major event in the Town.
6. The Car Boot Sale Manager has the authority to cancel the Car Boot Sale for any reason.
7. In the event that the Car Boot Sale is cancelled, You will be entitled to a full refund.
8. Selling is not permitted before 9am or after 2pm.
9. You must pay the correct fee to the marshal before entering the site.
10. Vehicles will be escorted on site from 8am and vehicles must be positioned where allocated by the marshal.
11. Reversing vehicles must be guided by a member of staff.
12. The Market and Car Boot Sale Manager may alter any vehicle location or change the layout of the Car Boot Sale Site on any occasion at any time for any reason. You will not have exclusive occupation of any Pitch.
13. Vehicles must have their engines switched off during trading hours.
14. You must have valid vehicle insurance.
15. Sellers are reminded that it is their responsibility to ensure that the site is left in a clean and tidy condition and no waste or unsold items are left on site.
16. You must obtain all necessary licences and consents relevant to the goods that you are trading.
17. The sale of alcohol, tobacco, live animals, fireworks, offensive weapons, pornographic material, unsafe, illegal or counterfeit goods is prohibited. Persons seen to be selling any of these will be escorted from the site and reported to Trading Standards.
18. Food sellers are not permitted as part of the car boot sale but are invited to trade as part of the market.
19. No raffles or lotteries are permitted unless they are duly licensed by the Council.
20. The Seller shall not offer for sale any goods which by reason of size smell noise condition or nature are, in the opinion of the Council, objectionable for any reason.
21. Selling by amplification is not permitted. Any noise which may cause a nuisance, annoyance or offence to any person is not permitted.
22. You shall not cause nuisance, annoyance or danger or interfere with any other person using or trading in the car boot sale or Market.
23. Vehicle registration numbers will be noted on the day as a record of attendance. Any persons seen to be breaking any rules will be disqualified from attending future car boot sales.
