

THE BOROUGH OF EASTLEIGH (VIRTUAL PERMITS) ORDER 2019

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Eastleigh Borough Council pursuant to arrangements with Hampshire County Council has made the above mentioned Traffic Regulation Order in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under sections 1, 2, 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The effect of the Order is to introduce the ability for parking permits, Pay & Display tickets and waiver certificates issued by Eastleigh Borough Council to be kept as an electronic record by Eastleigh Borough Council, instead of being displayed in a vehicle. The Order will come into operation on 9 September 2019. Any persons wishing to question the validity of this Order or any provisions contained in it on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, or any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within six weeks from 23 August 2019 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
