

THE BOROUGH OF EASTLEIGH (EASTLEIGH TOWN CENTRE)
(AMENDMENT NO.X) ORDER 201X

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Eastleigh Borough Council pursuant to arrangements under Section 19 of the Local Government Act 2000 with Hampshire County Council proposes to make the Order above in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police.

The Highways Agency are undertaking works to improve traffic flows at junction 5 of the M27. Work includes:

- widening of the M27 eastbound exit slip road, Stoneham Way and the A335 Wide Lane to three lanes;
- sections of the northern half of the roundabout will also be widened to three lanes;
- construction of a segregated left turn lane from A335 Wide Lane onto the eastbound M27 entry slip-road; and
- installation of new traffic signals on the northern section of the roundabout.

In order to widen Stoneham Way to three lanes the Highways Agency propose to stop-up the existing layby and construct a new one which is approximately 25 metres shorter in length and located slightly further north. This work will require the existing waiting restrictions on Stoneham Lane to be amended.

The effect of this order will be to revoke the existing waiting restrictions on Stoneham Way and to re-introduce the restriction limiting waiting to one hour within the new layby. A no waiting at any time restriction will be re-introduced along the rest of Stoneham Way.

The Highways Agency scheme and associated traffic regulation order to amend waiting restrictions on Stoneham Way will help to reduce congestion and improve safety.

A copy of the Order together with a plan showing the roads to which the Order relates and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at my office at Eastleigh House, Upper Market Street, Eastleigh during normal office hours or on the Council's website www.eastleigh.gov.uk/TRO.

Objections to these proposals together with the grounds on which they are made must be sent in writing to the undersigned or via the objections to traffic orders on the Council's website by 29 August 2014. Letters of support will also be received during this time.
