Notice is hereby given that on 6 April 2016 Eastleigh Borough Council made the above named Order under section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990. The effect of the Order will be to stop up a section running from point D on the plan attached to the Order approximately south, before turning approximately south-east to point E on the plan attached to the Order for a total distance of approximately 273 metres. The Order will also create an alternative footpath commencing at point F on the plan attached to the Order, running approximately south to point E shown on the plan attached to the Order, measuring approximately 272 metres long. Note that point F is intended to be connected to point D by the footpath to be created pursuant to '(Footpath labelled D-F-G-H, Hatch Farm, West End) Public Footpath Stopping Up Order 2016'.

The stopping up and creation of a new footpath is necessary to enable development to be carried out in accordance with planning application F/15/77718, the construction of 98 dwellings with access from Barbe Baker Avenue and Barnsland, West End, Hampshire. Any representations about or objections to the Order may be made in writing to the Head of Legal and Democratic Services, Eastleigh Borough Council, Eastleigh House, Upper Market Street, Eastleigh, Hampshire, SO50 9YN no later than 9 May 2016.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, Eastleigh Borough Council may itself confirm the Order as an unopposed Order. If the Order is sent to the Secretary of State for confirmation any representations and objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the Order.
