

**THE BOROUGH OF EASTLEIGH (HEDGE END,
WEST END AND BOTLEY)
(AMENDMENT NO. 7) (PART 1) ORDER 2019**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN Eastleigh Borough Council, as agent for Hampshire County Council (the Traffic Authority), has made the above mentioned Traffic Regulation Order in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 1, 2, 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The effect of the Order is to:

1. Remove "No waiting at any time" restrictions in the following road: **Yardley Road** both sides from its junction with Bursledon Road in a south-easterly direction for a distance of 15 metres and from a point 14 metres east of its junction with Yardley Road (southern spur) in a north-easterly direction for a distance of 8 metres.
2. Introduce "No waiting at any time" restrictions in the following roads: **Aspen Close**, *both sides* from its junction with Whitebeam Road for 10 metres in a north westerly direction, **Granada Road** *north-west side* from 10 metres south-west of its junction with Oak Tree Gardens to a point 10 metres north-east of that junction, **Oak Tree Gardens** *both sides* from its junction with Granada Road for 10 metres in a north westerly direction, **Oatlands Road** *south-east side* from a point 10 metres south-west of its junction with Ravenscroft Way to a point 10 metres north-east of that junction, **Ravenscroft Way** *both sides* from its junction with Oatlands Road for 10 metres in a south easterly direction, **September Close** *both sides* from its junction with Upper New Road for 10 metres in a north westerly direction, **The Foxgloves** *both sides* from a point in line with the common property boundary of property Nos 42 & 43 in a north easterly direction to its junction with Tanhouse Lane, **Ullswater Avenue** *both sides* from its junction with Eden Road for 10 metres in a south westerly direction, **Upper Northam Road** *south-east side* from a point 15 metres south west of its junction with Netley Firs Road for 45 metres in a north easterly direction, from a point 15 metres south west of its junction with St Catherines View for 40 metres in a north easterly direction, from a point 11 metres north-east of the common property boundary of property no's 74a & 74b for 258 metres in a north easterly direction, north-west side from a point 10 metres south west of its junction with Chalice Court for 325 metres in a north easterly direction, **Upper Northam Road (access off Upper Northam Road leading to Yew Tree Close)**, *north-west side* from a point in line with the common property boundary of property Nos 60/58 in a north easterly direction to its junction with Upper Northam Road, north-east side from its junction with Upper Northam Road for 5 metres in a south easterly direction, **Wheatsheaf Court** *both sides* From its junction with Upper Northam Road for 10 metres in a south easterly direction, **Whitebeam Road** *north-west side* from a point 10 metres south-west of its junction with Aspen Close to a point 10 metres north-east of that junction, **Wilderness Heights** *both sides* from its junction with West End Road for 10 metres in a north westerly direction, west side from a point in line with the northern building line of property no 37 for 20 metres in a north westerly direction, east side from a point 10 metres south of its junction with the eastern arm of Wilderness Heights (no's 25-36) for 20 metres in a north westerly direction, **Yardley Road** *both sides* from a point 2 metres north east of the common property boundary of property Nos 1c/1b in a south westerly and then north westerly direction to its junction with Bursledon Road.

The Order will come into operation on 3 August 2020. A copy of the Order may be inspected at my office at the Eastleigh House, Upper Market Street, Eastleigh during normal office hours or on the Council's website: www.eastleigh.gov.uk/TRO

Any persons wishing to question the validity of this Order or any provisions contained in it on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, or any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within six weeks from 22 July 2020 apply to the High Court for this purpose
