

**THE BOROUGH OF EASTLEIGH  
(HEDGE END, WEST END AND BOTLEY)  
(AMENDMENT NO. 8) ORDER 2020**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** the Eastleigh Borough Council pursuant to arrangements with Hampshire County Council has made the above mentioned Traffic Regulation Order in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 1, 2, 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The effect of the Order will be to:

1. Revoke items 464 & 465a relating to Upper St Helen's Road from the First Schedule to The Borough of Eastleigh (Hedge End, West End and Botley) Consolidation Order 2015 as amended.
2. Introduce "No waiting at any time" restrictions in the following roads: **Heath House Close**, *both sides* from its junction with Heath House Lane southwards for 15 metres; **Heath House Lane**, *south side* from a point 6 metres east of Heath House Close westwards to the boundary of "Tremar" and 2 Fredricks Cottages; **Stockholm Drive** *north-east side* from its junction with Upper St Helens Road south-eastwards for 10 metres; south-west side from its junction with Upper St Helens Road south-eastwards for 16 metres; **Upper St Helens Road** *west & north-west side* from its junction with Heath House Lane northwards and north-eastwards to a point 5 metres north-east of the property boundary of Nos 47b & 49; south-east side from a point 15 metres south-west of its junction with Stockholm Drive north-eastwards to a point 23 metres north-east of that junction.

The proposals relating to Lyons Place have been abandoned.

The Order will come into operation on 3 August 2020 .
