

**THE BOROUGH OF EASTLEIGH
(CHANDLER'S FORD AND HILTINGBURY)
(AMENDMENT NO 7) ORDER 2020**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Eastleigh Borough Council pursuant to arrangements with Hampshire County Council has made the above mentioned Traffic Regulation Order in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 1, 2, 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The effect of the Order will be to:

1. Introduce "No waiting at any time" restrictions in the following roads: **Hiltingbury Road north-east side** from its junction with Kingsway south-eastwards for 20 metres, south-west side— from its junction with Kingsway south-eastwards for 58 metres; **Peverells Wood Avenue north-east side** from its junction with Winchester Road south-eastwards to a point 38 metres south-east of the boundary of Nos 1 & 3
2. Introduce "No waiting at any time on verges" restrictions in the following road: **Hiltingbury Road north-east side** from a point 19 metres north-west of its junction with Malibres Road to a point 20 metres south-east of its junction with Kingsway, south-west side from a point 19 metres north-west of its junction with Malibres Road to a point 58 metres south-east of its junction with Kingsway

The provisions of the deferred items from THE BOROUGH OF EASTLEIGH (CHANDLER'S FORD AND HILTINGBURY) (AMENDMENT NO 6) ORDER 2020 have been incorporated into this Order

The Order will come into operation on 10 August 2020. A copy of the Order may be inspected at my office at the Eastleigh House, Upper Market Street, Eastleigh during normal office hours or on the Councils website: www.eastleigh.gov.uk/TRO

Any persons wishing to question the validity of this Order or any provisions contained in it on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, or any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within six weeks from **29 July 2020** apply to the High Court for this purpose.
