

THE BOROUGH OF EASTLEIGH (BURSLEDON, HAMBLE-LE-RICE AND HOUND)
(AMENDMENT NO 10) ORDER 2020

The Council of the Borough of Eastleigh (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") pursuant to arrangements made with the Hampshire County Council in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 1, 2 and 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby makes the following Order:-

Commencement and Citation

1. This Order shall come into operation on 7 November 2020 and may be cited as the "The Borough of Eastleigh (Bursledon, Hamble-Le-Rice and Hound) (Amendment No 10) Order 2020."

Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting

2. In this Order the Principal Order means The Borough of Eastleigh (Bursledon, Hamble-Le-Rice and Hound) (Consolidation) Order 2012 as amended.
3. The contents of Schedule 1 shall be inserted into the Fourth Schedule to the Principal Order.
4. The contents of Schedule 2 shall be inserted into the Twentieth Schedule to the Principal Order.
5. The contents of Schedule 3 shall be inserted into the Twenty-second Schedule to the Principal Order
6. The contents of Schedule 4 shall be deleted from the Twenty-second Schedule to the Principal Order
7. The contents of Schedule 5 shall be inserted into the Seventeenth Schedule to the Principal Order
8. The contents of Schedule 6 shall be deleted from the Seventeenth Schedule to the Principal Order
