EASTLEIGH BOROUGH COUNCIL

BYELAWS FOR GOOD RULE AND GOVERNMENT

Byelaws made under section 235 of the Local Government Act 1972 by the Borough Council of Eastleigh for the good rule and government of the Borough of Eastleigh and for the prevention and suppression of nuisances.

INTERPRETATION

1. In these byelaws:

"the Council" means the Borough Council of Eastleigh.

EXTENT

2. These byelaws apply throughout the Eastleigh Borough Council unless otherwise indicated.

PRESERVATION OF ROAD MARGINS

INTERPRETATION

3. In these byelaws:

"carriageway", "highway" and "trunk road" have the same meaning as in the Highways Act 1980.

EXTENT

4. These byelaws apply to any road margin which is:

- (i) adjacent to the carriageway of a highway, other than to the carriageway of a trunk road vested in the Secretary of State;
- (ii) laid or sown with grass or planted with trees, shrubs or plants, and mown or otherwise maintained in an ornamental condition by the Council; and
- (iii) indicated to be a margin to which these byelaws apply by means of a notice conspicuously displayed on or near the said margin by the Council.

RIDING ON ROAD MARGINS

5. No person shall without lawful authority ride or lead any horse, or cause any horse to be ridden or led upon any road margin to which these byelaws apply.

VEHICLES

6. No person shall, without lawful authority, drive or place a vehicle (other than a heavy commercial vehicle as defined by section 36A of the road Traffic Act 1972) or cause such a vehicle to be driven or placed upon any road margin to which this byelaw applies.

SKATEBOARDING, ETC

INTERPRETATION

7. In these byelaws:

"highway" means the whole or a part of a highway other than a ferry or waterway;

"carriageway" means a way constituting or comprised in a highway, being a way (other than a cycle track) over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles;

"footway" means a way comprised in a highway which also comprises a carriageway, being a way over which the public have a right of way on foot only;

"designated area" means any area named in the Schedule to these byelaws.

EXTENT

8. (1) Byelaw 9(1) applies throughout the Borough of Eastleigh but not to any designated area.
(2) Byelaw 9(2) applies to all designated areas.

SKATEBOARDING

9. (1) No person shall on any footway or carriageway skate on rollers, skateboards, wheels or other mechanical contrivances in such a manner as to cause danger or nuisance or give reasonable grounds for annoyance to other persons lawfully using the footway or carriageway.
(2) No person shall skate on rollers, skateboards, wheels or other mechanical contrivances in a designated area.

NOISE IN STREETS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES

10. No person in a street or other public place shall, after being requested to desist by a constable, or by any person annoyed or disturbed, or by any person acting on his behalf:
 - (a) by shouting or singing;
 - (b) by playing on a musical instrument; or
 - (c) by operating or permitting to be operated any radio, gramophone, amplifier, tape recorder or similar instrument

cause or permit to be made any noise which is so loud or so continuous or repeated as to give reasonable cause for annoyance to other persons in the neighbourhood.

11. This byelaw shall not apply to properly conducted religious services or to any person holding or taking part in any entertainment held with the consent of the Council.

DANGEROUS GAMES NEAR STREETS

12. No person shall on any land adjoining a street play any game in a manner likely to cause obstruction to any traffic or to cause danger to any person in such a street.

TOUTING

13. No person shall in any street or public place for the purpose of selling or advertising any article or obtaining custom tout or importune to the annoyance or obstruction of passengers.

FIREWORKS, ETC. IN PLACES OF ENTERTAINMENT

14. No person shall, with intent to cause annoyance or inconvenience to any person in any place of entertainment to which the public are admitted with or without the payment of money, while the public are on the premises, throw or set off any firework, stink-bomb or similar article, or squirt, spray or otherwise throw or scatter any offensive liquid, powder or substance in any such place as aforesaid.

INTERFERENCE WITH ROAD WARNING LAMPS

15. No person shall in any street, to the obstruction, annoyance or danger of the residents or passengers, without lawful authority move or tamper with any lamp, reflector or other apparatus used for giving warning of, or lighting, any obstruction, excavation or other danger.

INTERFERENCE WITH LIFE SAVING APPLIANCES

16. Except in case of emergency no person shall remove, displace or otherwise interfere with any life saving appliances placed by the Council or other competent authority in any street or public place.

URINATING, ETC.

17. No person shall urinate or defecate in any public place.

PENALTY

18. Any person offending against any of these byelaws shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 2 on the standard scale.

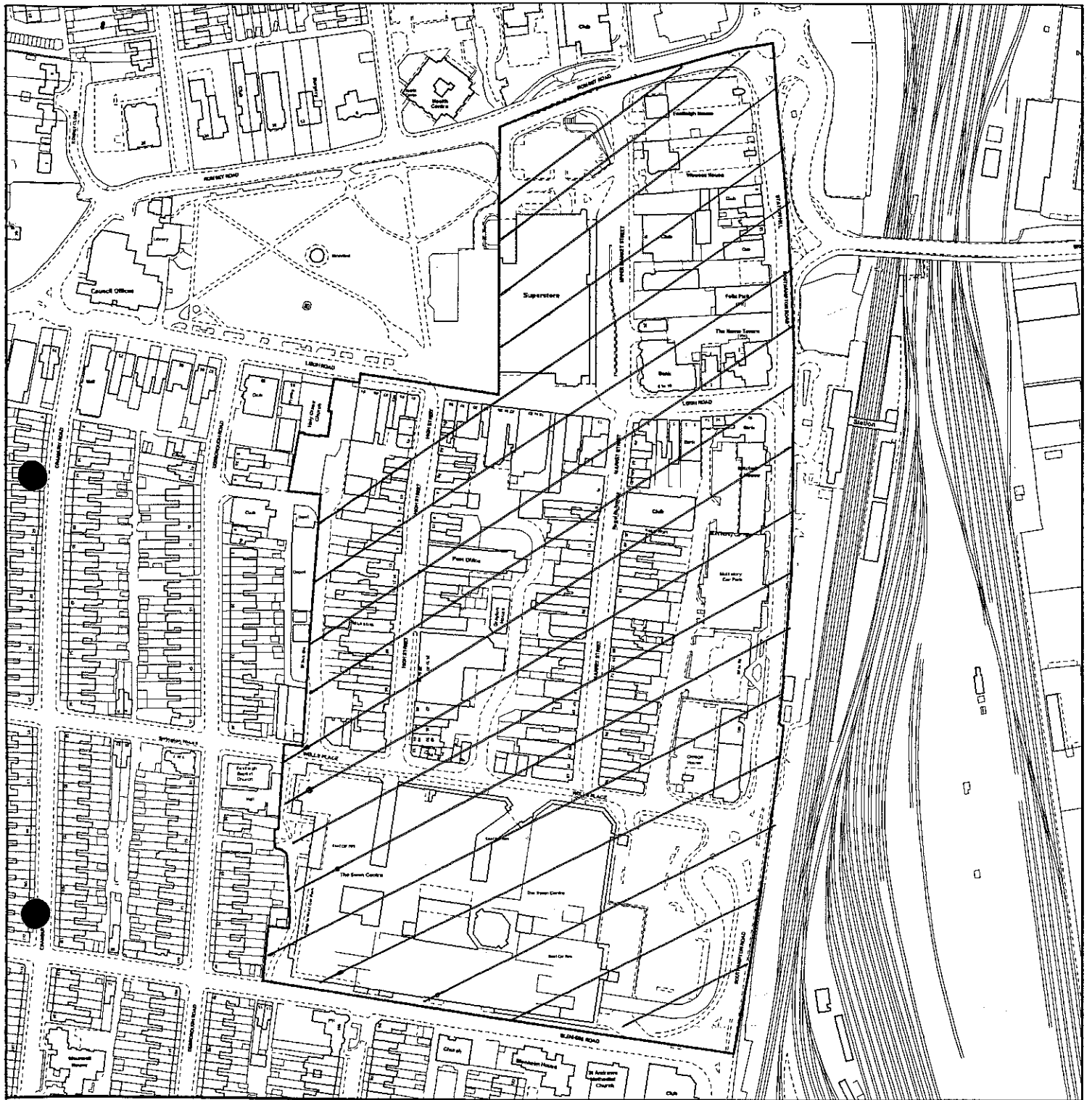

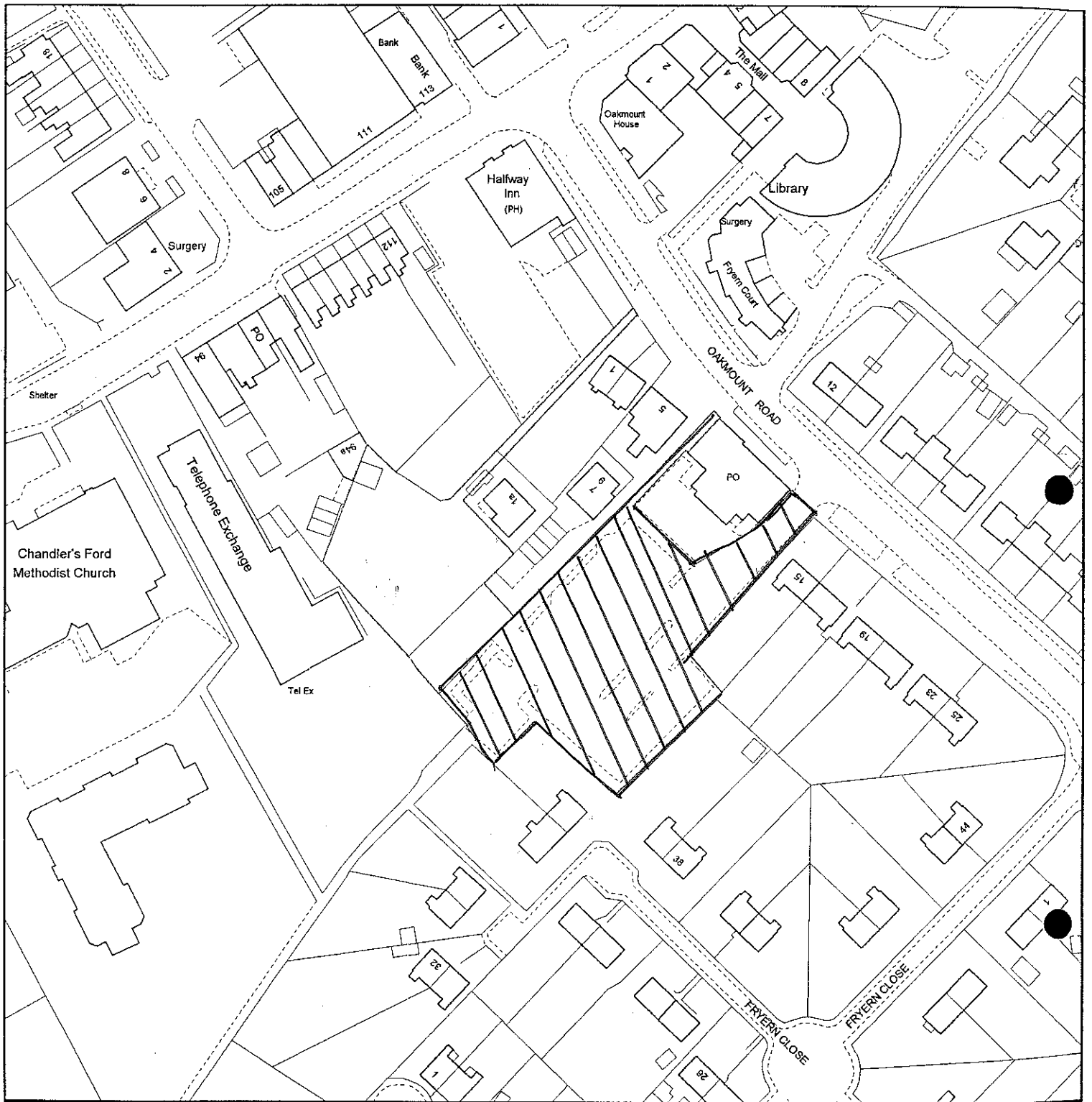
