

**THE BOROUGH OF EASTLEIGH
(EASTLEIGH TOWN CENTRE)
(AMENDMENT NO 13) ORDER 2021**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN Eastleigh Borough Council, as agent for Hampshire County Council (the Traffic Authority),” has made the above mentioned Traffic Regulation Order in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under Sections 1, 2, 4 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The general effect of this Order is to insert into The Borough of Eastleigh (Eastleigh Town Centre) (Consolidation) Order 2013 as detailed below.

1. Introduce “No waiting at any time” restrictions in the following road: **Wiltshire Road east side** from a point 30 metres north of its junction with Belmont Road northwards for a distance of 20 metres
2. Remove Disabled persons’ parking places in the following road: **Wiltshire Road west side** from the boundary between house numbers 22 and 24 to the boundary between house numbers 20 and 22, and from a point 1.5 metres north of the northern boundary of No. 2 Wiltshire Road northwards for a distance of 6.5 metres
3. Introduce Disabled persons’ parking places in the following road: **Wiltshire Road east side** from the boundary of house number 20 and 22 northwards for 6.6 metres, and from a point 1.5 metres north of the northern boundary of No. 2 Wiltshire Road northwards for a distance of 6.6 metres.

The Order will come into operation on 19 April 2021. A copy of the Order may be inspected at my office at the Eastleigh House, Upper Market Street, Eastleigh during normal office hours or on the Council’s website: www.eastleigh.gov.uk/TRO

Any persons wishing to question the validity of this Order or any provisions contained in it on the grounds that any requirement of the Act, or any instrument made under that Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may within six weeks from 14 April 2021 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
